A time for new beginnings!

Happy New Year! Each year, January brings with it a time for new beginnings, at home and at school. At Calvary, we are excited to return for a new year, filled with new and familiar opportunities!

Throughout the month of January, we will explore the curriculum theme "Snowy Science," as we learn about all things winter. We will also explore the winter weather outdoors on our playground daily, so please be sure your child continues to arrive to school prepared for outdoor winter play.

From January 16th-23rd, we are having a Peanut Butter and Jelly drive for the West Chester Food Cupboard! We are collecting peanut butter (or other

"butter" substitute) and jelly to give to children in our local community as we learn about Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and participate in the National Day of Service. Your child can help pick out their favorite (non-perishable) sandwich ingredients to bring to school for our drive. Children will learn about ways to help others in their homes, in the school, and in their local community.

Playground pickup for January is scheduled for Thursday, January 4th (weather permitting). At pickup, families will park in the Rosedale Ave. lot and meet their child's class on the playground for pickup. Families are invited to take this opportunity to play and chat before leaving for the day!

Summer camp 2024 registration begins on January 10th! Registration packets for summer camp will be distributed on your child's first days back to school in January. These are 4, week-long sessions, and families can choose from any of the 4 weeks. Sign-ups are on a first come, first-served basis. Spots are limited, and will also be open to new families, so be sure to submit your registration form ASAP. Please see the camp information packet for details on timing and registration. If you have any questions, please let me know.

2024-2025 school year registration also begins on January 10th. Registration packets will be distributed on your child's first days back to school in January. Registration for current families, alumni families, and church member families runs from January 10th-17th, and then registration for new families begins on January 18th.


